

DEMA PRESSURE INDICATING TEE

MODELS: 68-6, 68-6-QD1 & 68-6-QD2

The DEMA Pressure Indicating Tee is designed to protect faucet backflow devices not rated for continuous supply pressure and to virtually eliminate hot cold water cross connection.

DEMA's Pressure Tee is tested and complies with the national plumbing standard ASSE 1055-1997 for Chemical Dispensing Systems. This standard and device is required by some state and local regulatory agencies when connecting devices (such as DEMA dispensers) to the potable water supply. Check local plumbing regulations for back flow and connection requirements before installing any DEMA chemical dispenser.

DEMA's Pressure Tee bleeds pressure from the faucet by discharging a narrow stream of water into the sink from the bottom of the device when the faucet is open. This relieves enough pressure to not damage the faucet backflow device and provides a visual indication to turn the water off. The visual indication is proven to alleviate hot cold cross connection. A hot cold cross connection can occur when both hot and cold water are connected to the dispenser and left on creating the potential for hot or cold water to migrate into the others supply pipes.

DEMA offers three versions of the Pressure Indicating Tee that connect to the faucet / water supply with garden hose threads (68-6), male quick connect (68-6-QD1), or male quick connect with female quick connect (68-6-QD2) included.
